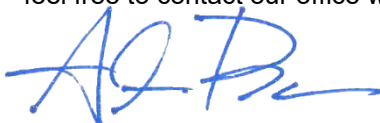
Verdantas has checked the bids for mathematical errors and prepared a bid tabulation (see attached). Twelve bids were received, and ten were under the engineer's estimate of \$890,000.00 with the remaining two being within the allowable 20% of the estimate. One minor mathematical error was found within the bid from Silver Bridge Excavating. This is shown on the bid tabulation.

Hazen Services LLC. is the apparent low bidder. Verdantas staff have worked with Hazen Services on many waterline and street projects in the past. The projects were successful with positive outcomes for the owners. The County's Water and Wastewater team has also completed some projects utilizing Hazen Services.

Based on the qualification statement provided and our previous work history with the contractor, we recommend the contract be awarded in the amount of **\$649,470.00** to:

We have received Request for Information (RFI) on this project. Those questions and responses are below:

Q: Is directionally drilling the open trench applications with HDPE acceptable?

A: The county is a PVC system. While they utilize HDPE for crossings, they do not have equipment and materials for a HDPE system. Please bid per plan

Q: The detail indicates 12" of Backfill for in the influence and under the influence of the road. Is that correct?

A: On the Under the Influence Trench details, the 12" granular that you are referring to is above the pipe. However, after the 12" above the pipe, you will see it calls for compacted granular or flowable fill. So the complete trench would be either all compacted granular or a combination of compacted granular/flowable fill.

Q. To clarify Lines 1-2, 2, and 3. Labeled phase 2 are not included in this bid correct?

A: Correct. This project is for Phase 1 only. Refer to sheet 4, Site Map, for Phase 1 area.

Q: Can all watermain on the project be installed utilizing HDD? If so, C900 CertaLok or HDPE?

A: While consideration could be made to do additional horizontal directional drilling (HDD) in lieu of open trench, please bid the project per plan. With the number of existing utilities, number of service taps, and locations of valves and hydrants, there will need to be numerous locations of open trench any way. See above question regarding additional use of HDPE.

Q: Can portable traffic lights be used to close portions of the south bound lane on SR-13 where work is being performed, reopening nightly.

A: The permit application with Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) was submitted utilizing temporary traffic control (signs, cones, flaggers, safety vehicles, etc.) for work in the shoulder. However, use of other traffic control devices is acceptable as long as they meet the requirements of the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (OMUTCD).

We have received additional Request for Information (RFI) on this project. Those questions and responses are below:

Q: Is there any soil boring for the job?

A: No geotechnical exploration was completed for this project.

Q: Was there any rock when the sanitary sewer was installed?

A: With no geotechnical exploration as part of the project, all excavations are unclassified. Per Licking County Water & Wastewater (LCW&WW), no substantial rock was encountered during the sanitary sewer project in the adjacent area.

Q: Does the county do the inspection for the job?

A: Yes, LCW&WW will have project inspection.

Q: Do we need a SWPPP [sic] plan?

A: Since this project was reduced to Phase 1 only, it is not anticipated that this project will disturb enough acreage to require a full stormwater pollution prevention plan (SWPPP). However, the contractor is required to utilize best management practices (BMPs) for stormwater. See the sheets 2, 23 and 24 of the Project Plans for additional information.

Q: Do we have to pay for water usage? Where is the water source?

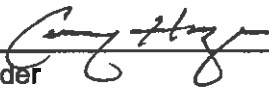
A: Water utilized to fill and flush the new waterline as part of testing will not have a charge from LCW&WW. Hauled water for use of drilling operations, dust control, etc. can be obtained for a cost from LCW&WW with Contractor provided metering and backflow and proper coordination. The location would be near the intersection of US40 and Lancer Road (approx. 1.5 miles from project). The cost per 1,000 gallons would be \$6.50.

Q: Is 304 limestone required for granular backfill or gravel 304?


A: LCW&WW utilizes Construction and Materials Specifications for Columbus (CMSC) with some deviations and exceptions as noted in other details. Granular backfill for trenches follows CMSC 703.11, 801.13 and 801.14. However, the use of limestone (angular) is not permitted for bedding or haunching around the pipe material (below, around, and 12" above). Contractor will need to use limestone material for the depths of aggregate material detailed in Surface Repair Details on sheet 20 of the Project Plans.
